Un'Estensione di Roma

Le colonie romane rappresentavano un'estensione fisica e politica della città di Roma. Fondate per vari motivi strategici, economici o demografici, queste nuove città godevano di un alto grado di autonomia, ma mantenevano un legame indissolubile con la madrepatria. I coloni, spesso veterani dell'esercito romano o cittadini romani provenienti da altre regioni, ricevevano terre e privilegi speciali, contribuendo alla stabilità e alla romanizzazione delle nuove aree. Le colonie erano spesso progettate secondo un preciso schema urbanistico, con un forum, un tempio dedicato a Giove e un sistema di strade ben organizzato. Questo dimostrava la volontà di Roma di imporre la propria cultura e struttura sociale nei territori conquistati. Un esempio emblematico è Ostia Antica, il porto di Roma, fondato come colonia per garantire il controllo delle rotte marittime e lo sviluppo del commercio. La sua prosperità economica e la sua organizzazione urbanistica testimoniano l'importanza strategica delle colonie nell'espansione romana.

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scholarship has widely debated the question about the existence of an italian identity in the time of the roman republic basing on the few sources available and on the outcomes of the augustan and imperial age in this sense this debate has for a long time been conducted without sufficient input from social sciences and particularly from social geography which has developed methodologies and models for the investigation of identities this book starts therefore from the consideration that italy came to be by the end of the republic a region within the roman imperium and investigates the ways this happened and its consequences on the local populations and their identity structures it shows that italy gained a territorial and symbolic shape and own institutions defining it as a territorial region and that a regional identity developed as a consequence by the 2nd century bce the original interdisciplinary approach to the matter allows a

consistent revision of the ancient sources and sheds now light on the topic providing important reflections for future studies on the subject

according to one narrative that received almost canonical status a century ago with francis haverfield the orthogonal grid was the most important development of ancient town planning embodying values of civilization in contrast to barbarism diffused in particular by hundreds of roman colonial foundations and its main legacy to subsequent urban development was the model of the grid city spread across the new world in new colonial cities this book explores the shortcomings of that all too colonialist narrative and offers new perspectives it explores the ideals articulated both by ancient city founders and their modern successors it looks at new evidence for roman colonial foundations to reassess their aims and it looks at the many ways post roman urbanism looked back to the roman model with a constant re appropriation of the idea of the roman

presenting a new and revealing overview of the ruling classes of the roman empire this volume explores aspects of the relations between the official state structures of rome and local provincial elites the central objective of the volume is to present as complex a picture as possible of the provincial leaderships and their many and varied responses to the official state structures the perspectives from which issues are approached by the contributors are as multiple as the realities of the roman world from historical and epigraphic studies to research of philological and linguistic interpretations and from architectural analyses to direct interpretations of the material culture while some local potentates took pride in their relationship with rome and their use of latin exhibiting their allegiances publicly as well as privately others preferred to keep this display solely for public manifestation these complex and complementary pieces of research provide an in depth image of the power mechanisms within the roman state the chronological span of the volume is from rome s republican conquest of greece to the changing world of the fourth and fifth centuries ad when a new ecclesiastical elite began to emerge

the oxford handbook of pre roman italy provides a comprehensive account of the many peoples who lived on the italian peninsula during the last millennium bce written by more than fifty authors the book describes the diversity of these indigenous cultures their languages interactions and reciprocal influences it gives emphasis to greek colonization the rise of aristocracies technological innovations and the spread of literacy which provided the urban texture that shaped the history of the italian peninsula

this research represents a pivotal advancement in our understanding of the complex interactions between rome and noricum initially integrated as a kingdom noricum underwent a formal transition to roman rule several decades later notably the spread of roman culture did not originate from rome itself but rather from aquileia a key center situated near noricum s southern border which had established exchanges with noricum even before its annexation into the empire central to this study is aquileia a latin colony founded in 181 bc in northeastern italy the rich epigraphic and archaeological records from aquileia along with findings from southern noricum illuminate the evolving ties between these areas from their pre roman relations to early roman interactions through their annexation and into the following centuries noricum s strategic location on the empire s northern edge rich in natural resources allowed this research to encompass multiple sectors such as trade customs mining military distribution religious syncretism and artistic influences aquileia s vibrant environment fostered significant cultural and economic exchanges enabling citizens to pursue diverse opportunities in business military and public service which transformed the local context by integrating diverse historical scholarship this study deepens our

understanding of noricum s cultural evolution revealing the profound impact of its relationships with aquileia such interactions laid the groundwork for essential political economic and cultural transitions throughout noricum s history extending into the severan period this research provides not only a wealth of information but also offers fresh perspectives and inspire further inquiry into the complexities of roman provincial life whether one is seeking to understand the nuances of local governance the significance of archaeological findings or the interplay of cultural exchanges in the region the alpine connections aquileia and noricum serves as a vital reference that enriches our understanding of the roman empire s enduring legacy and its far reaching influences
